JOB DESCRIPTION – YOUTH MINISTRY PASTOR

CONTEXT

Youth Ministry is a vital part of Rivergum community church, and exists to help fulfil its Mission and Vision.

OUR MISSION: *Through Jesus Christ, to help people belong, believe and become all God wants them to be.*

- 5 To work with the Ministry Team in evaluating and improving the effectiveness of the Youth ministry.
