Tips for moving to online gatherings

- If you want to live stream a service, but do not have the infrastructure, all you need is:
 - A smartphone;
 - A tripod (like [this](#) one); and
 - A free Youtube channel, or a Facebook page (using Facebook Live)
- If you want an interactive meeting, Zoom (<https://zoom.us>) allows you to connect to 100 people for free for 40 minutes. If you want to stream for longer than 40 minutes, then they charge \$21/month (a relatively small investment), or [more](#) if you want more than 100 people to watch/interact.
- For those who are in the room, you need to acknowledge that you are recording or live streaming the service *at the beginning of the service* so that people know they are being recorded.
- Be mindful that you do not divulge personal and sensitive identifying information, particularly during announcements and prayer time.
- Make sure that any music or videos you use are within your licensing and copyright requirements (<https://au.ccli.com>). You cannot just download content from YouTube and play it. Please ensure you have the appropriate permissions.
