FRONTIER

The frontier is the border between what is known and familiar, and what lies beyond. It calls those who have an adventurous spirit who are willing to risk leaving behind what is known to try something new, with the hope that this new thing might hold life.

The frontier is not the place for the faint of heart. It requires a willingness to try new things, and the humility to try again. It requires adaptability to a new environment and the agility to respond to change. It also requires an underlying steadfastness of faith, perseverance towards hope, and rootedness in love.

How might new communities of Christ be seeded in creative and adventurous ways that move beyond what is known and familiar? We are looking for pioneers, people who Jesus is calling to the frontier of His kingdom work of reaching people with His gospel by pioneering new ways of doing so.

Fresh Hope Pioneering gathers such pioneers for a year of shared learning, discipleship and discernment with the purpose of being primed for mission.

We call this year Frontier because together we grow in our capacity to do Kingdom work at the border of what is known and what lies beyond.

THE FRONTIER JOURNEY MARCH-NOVEMBER

Learn:

Frontier comprises of nine month-long units each with readings, teachings and "co-labs" of formation and discussion, all conducted online. Pioneering coaching and mentoring take place throughout the year.

Practice:

Fieldwork brings the learning to life and is practiced weekly, including experiments and challenges. The cohort also practices a set of spiritual disciplines together throughout the year.

Gather:

We gather in person as a cohort for initial (March), mid-way (September) and final (November) 'live-ins' to deepen in formation and integrate and discern what God is up to.

Commit:

Frontier calls for a base commitment of 12 hours a week.

Frontier is provided by Fresh Hope Pioneering in partnership with the Australian College of Ministries (ACOM). Over the course of the year, you can complete two subjects through ACOM. ACOM is a Member Institute of the Sydney College of Divinity who offer internationally recognised higher education awards.
